Step One:

collect snippets.

Write everything down: tiny scenes, lines, ideas, images.

Step Two:

identify themes.

Look through your list of snippets and sort them into themes.

What themes have you picked out?

Step Three: pick one theme.

What do you really want to say about it?

What kind of antagonist or conflict will help you express those ideas?

Step Four: basic outline.

Devise images for your beginning, middle, and end that make strong statements about your theme.

Step Five: flesh it out!

Find places for as many of your snippets as possible. Use this space to think about where specific lines, scenes, characters, or ideas might fit in.
